“Heart Health for Women”

Longmont United Hospital will be hosting “Heart Health for Women” on Thursday, February 7 from 5:00 – 6:00 p.m. Dr. Linda Backup will be presenting the symptoms and risk factors of cardiovascular disease for women and how women can avoid it. Health screenings of blood pressure, heart rate and blood oxygen levels will be available. Reduced-cost lipid panel will also be offered (see below).

Dr. Backup is experienced in cardiac catheterizations, coronary angioplasties, thallium stress tests, exercise stress tests, echocardiograms and stress echocardiograms.
