Our Donors are the *Foundation* of Our Success Celebrating 30 Years of Service to the Hospital

The Longmont United Hospital Foundation was incorporated 30 years ago in March 1981. At that time Longmont United Hospital was much smaller but the administration knew that it was going to need an ancillary source of funds to help with its continued growth. The administration and Board of Directors felt that a separate non profit foundation would be the best vehicle for building an endowment and attracting charitable gifts including cash, pledges, bequests, trusts and appreciated property.

The initial Foundation Board was comprised of volunteer community leaders who represented a diverse cross section of the community with different spheres of influence. The first meeting of the Board of Trustees was held April 1, 1981. Trustees included John Flanders, George Landers, Ruth Lehman, Ken Huey, Joe Johnson, D.W. McCarty, Carol Oswald, Vince Shryack, Maxine Haley, Vern Golden, Tom Brown, E. Carl Forgey, and Wayne Jurgens. This board established policies and created the vision which has guided the Foundation for the past 30 years.

The Longmont United Hospital Foundation's success has been a result of the community's generosity and willingness to support an organization they believe in and know will be good guardians of their charitable gifts. John Flanders, who was the Foundation's *first* and is also the *current* Chairman of the Board, has often remarked on Longmont's philanthropic spirit: " People in our area are very giving and I have personally dealt with many donors from all walks of life. The Foundation has consistently proven to be attractive to my clients and as a result, it has benefited greatly from their generosity. Many of them included the Foundation in their wills or established other types of planned giving. Fundraising is not always about immediate gifts. It's very much about cultivating and planting seeds that take time to grow and flourish."

The Foundation's donors have been instrumental in helping the hospital with many improvements and additions to the hospital over the past 30 years. The Hope Cancer Care Center which opened in 1996 was built almost exclusively from donor gifts and received over \$1.5 million. The patient tower which opened in 2000 was also strongly supported by our donor community which helped raise \$2.5 million. The new Emergency Department which opened in 2008 received over \$1.8 million from a multitude of donors. Over the past 30 years the Foundation has received over \$10 million dollars for various programs, services and equipment needs. These gifts are a tribute to the wonderful care given at Longmont United Hospital. We are extremely fortunate to have an exemplary medical facility in our community and donors' gifts are an expression of their appreciation. Our hospital was built over 50 years ago when the community pulled together and helped raise the money necessary to build a new hospital which opened in 1959. The Foundation is grateful to *all* of its donors who have made gifts both large and small.

Charitable Giving from Your Estate

Gifts by Will or Living Trust - A bequest is the most traditional way to provide important help for worthwhile causes. With a gift to the Longmont United Hospital Foundation through your will or living trust you will retain full use of your gift property during your life. It's also possible to make a gift at death but reserve lifetime income to a spouse or family member. Ask us for details. We will be happy to provide you or your attorney with sample bequest language.



Life Insurance - You can name us as the beneficiary of your life insurance - just contact the company. A better idea may be to transfer actual ownership of the policy to the Longmont United Hospital Foundation, or buy and contribute a new policy. Such a gift will entitle you to an income tax deduction, and future premium payments will be tax deductible.



Financial Accounts - Most accounts at financial institutions can be made payable at death to a person or a charitable organization. Ask the manager of the institution how you can arrange to designate the Foundation as a death beneficiary for your CD, savings account, brokerage account, etc. These gifts are revocable during life.



Benefits from IRAs and Pension Funds - Your estate can save both income taxes and estate taxes if you make the Longmont United Hospital Foundation the death beneficiary of your individual retirement account or other retirement savings plan. You can also arrange for lifetime income to be paid to a family member after your death, with the Foundation's benefit coming later.
