

Prescriptive Therapies and Service Fees

Prescriptive Therapies are services prescribed by your physician. To initiate the process of utilizing Prescriptive Therapies, we require the following:

- 1) A written prescription from the patient's physician for acupuncture, manual lymphatic drainage and/or medical massage therapy,
- 2) A copy of the patient's health insurance card, and
- 3) Verification of coverage and benefits for the specific service from the patient's insurance company. This often takes three business days. Our Insurance Specialist will contact the patient with any questions regarding insurance, prescription, or authorization and to discuss the best options with Prescriptive Therapies and Choice Therapies (self pay).

Once the insurance company has verified coverage and benefits, the first appointment is scheduled. At the first appointment, the patient signs the Prescriptive Therapies Information and Consent form. This process also applies to insurance claims for motor vehicle accidents.

Acupuncture Fees

One-hour appointment without electrical stimulation, \$305 (\$86 initial 15 minutes, \$73 each additional 15 minutes)

One-hour appointment with electrical stimulation, \$324 (\$93 initial 15 minutes, \$77 each additional 15 minutes)

Manual Lymphatic Drainage Fee

One-hour Appointment, \$324 (\$81 per 15 minutes)
Bandages and supplies billed separately or private pay if insurance does not cover.

Medical Massage Therapy Fee

One-hour Appointment - \$71 per 15 minutes

If you choose to submit your own bill to your insurance company and pay at the time of service, we offer Choice Therapies Fees with a superbill, a form that can be quickly completed and submitted to an insurance company or employer for reimbursement.
